



LEARNING SUPPORT FEES

Quality first Teaching and Individual Development Plans – inclusive

At Wynstones all teachers are SEND teachers, and assume a level of individuality for all students, in their learning styles, interests and motivations. On this basis **Individualised Development Plans** are ongoingly updated for all children.

Integrated into our provision is a level of learning support for all students, offered through Class and Subject Teachers, **Learning Support Tutors** and **Higher Learning Support Tutors**, deployed across the classes and supported by our **Inclusion Manager** (SENDCo). A range of auxiliary resources are also included in the school's provision for all students.

Our support for all students with SEND is structured through the 4-stage **Graduated Approach** of *assess-plan-do-review*. This is a collaborative approach involving all teachers in phase meetings, and termly reviews involving parent(s) / guardian(s) and students as appropriate.

The school's standard provision may include up to 6 individual **Learning Support** sessions (eg in literacy, numeracy, communication etc) in any one academic year. Additional sessions, whether as part of **Specialised Educational Provision** or catch-up sessions requested by parents, are chargeable.

Learning Support (including as part of Specialised Educational Provision) - chargeable

A range of interventions are available to support students' wellbeing and progress beyond the standard provision within the school's curriculum through students' **Individual Development Plans**.

These may include further individual **Learning Support** sessions (eg in literacy, numeracy, communication etc) in any one academic year, beyond the 6 that are included in the school's provision.

In addition, Learning Support sessions can extend to: Art Therapy, Speech Therapy and Play Therapy, charged at £35 per session, bookable in half-termly blocks.

Special Educational Provision (substantial and sustained Learning Support) incurs additional costs that can include the above interventions, as well as external assessments and tutors (provided at cost).

Where 1:1 support for students is required by either **Learning Support Tutors** or **Higher Learning Support Tutors**, these are established and arranged for periods of a half term at a time. The school meets part of the cost of these tutors, in order to be able to direct our range of staff as appropriate to support any individual student within their class. Any part provision of 1:1 Learning Support is charged pro-rata.
